Family Planning NSW is committed to providing age-appropriate, evidence-based comprehensive sexuality education (CSE) for people of all ages. Comprehensive sexuality education is learning that begins during early childhood, and continues throughout life, concerning the physical, emotional, mental and social aspect of sexual and reproductive health and rights, inclusive of sexuality and relationships. Considered to be a lifelong process, CSE extends beyond the school curriculum and should be accessible to all individuals regardless of age and their engagement with the education system.



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

Advocacy:

We promote the need for commitments to establish comprehensive sexuality education programs in schools and universities, and for the implementation of national sexual and reproductive health policies for all.



We actively support the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals, with a close alignment to SDG 3 on healthy lives and SDG 5 on gender equality.
